Over the season we offer a combination of scheduled sailings and viewings to give as many people as possible access to the wherries and an opportunity to find out about our work or even get involved as a volunteer or supporter.

Complimentary hot & cold drinks are served, but please bring your own food as required. Return land transport is included where necessary - we meet early at the destination of the sailing and transport you to the wherry. Sailing lengths and arrival times are approximate due to the influence of wind and tide. Full details of parking, meeting points, transport etc. will be given on booking. We are unable to accept dogs on board for scheduled sailings, except registered assistance dogs. The wherries are not suitable for wheelchairs, but please contact us with any other accessibility queries and we will do our best to enable you to join us.
